

**Zajęcia metodą projektu w warunkach pozaszkolnych – wskazania dotyczące organizacji oraz efektów pracy uczniów i nauczycieli w projekcie „Agent”
(zestaw zadań) – Marek Krawiec**

SET 1

1. Find the ‘Collegium Maius’ of the Nicholas Copernicus University in Fosa Staromiejska Street. Look at the facade of the building and write down what you can see between MCM and XLV.

ANSWER: IMAGE OF THE SUN

2. Turn around and look at the building with a round turret opposite the ‘Collegium Maius’. Write down what you can find in this building?

ANSWER: PRISON

3. Go to the Wilam Horzyca Theatre. Find two figures in front of the main entrance to the theatre and write down what the woman on the right is holding in her hands.

ANSWERS: RIGHT HAND – HARP, LEFT HAND – ROSE

4. Go to Podmurna Street and find the Cat’s Head Tower there. Which century was it built? What institute is located in the building now? For what purpose was the cellar of the tower used in the past?

ANSWERS: THE TOWER WAS BUILT IN 16th CENTURY, IN THE TOWER THERE IS THE INSTITUTE OF THE POLISH LANGUAGE, THE CELLAR WAS USED FOR IMPRISONING

5. How many ceramic sculptures can you find in the Passion Scene Gallery near the building at 50 Podmurna Street? Go to this street and count the sculptures very carefully. You cannot miss any of them.

ANSWER: THERE ARE 16 SCULPTURES

6. Walk quickly to Przedzamcze Street and find a dragon there. Read the legend about the creature on the information board on a neighbouring building and present it briefly in the English language.

ANSWER: ACCORDING TO TWO PERSONS WHO SAW THE DRAGON, THE CREATURE APPEARED IN THIS AREA TWICE. IT WAS IN 18TH CENTURY. THE DRAGON WAS ABOUT 2 METRES LONG, HAD 4 LEGS AND IT COULD FLY AND SWIM.

7. Go further along Przedzamcze Street until you reach the ruins of the Teutonic Knights Castle. Buy tickets for all of you and get into the ruins. Look around very carefully and check every place there. Your task is to find a miniature castle there and to take a photo of it (this is a model of the castle which stood in this place before).

8. Next to the ruins of the castle there is “Zamkowa” restaurant where one of your teachers is waiting for you. Get into the restaurant and ask the teacher the questions below – formulate them in English. Only two persons from your group may enter the building. Put down the answers given by the teacher.

- Jak długo planuje swój pobyt w Toruniu?
- Co chciałby/chciałaby zobaczyć w tym mieście?
- Dlaczego wybrał/a do zwiedzania Toruń, a nie na przykład Kraków?

After the conversation with the teacher, you will get another set of tasks.

SET 2

9. Find the Baj Pomorski Theatre near the ruins of the Teutonic Knights Castle. Have a look at this building and describe it very briefly in your own words.

ANSWER: IT'S QUITE EXTRAORDINARY. IT LOOKS LIKE A MAGICAL WARDROBE WITH SEVERAL NICELY CARVED DRAWERS INSIDE.

10. Go to Nowomiejski Market Square, look around and find St. Jame's Church (Świętego Jakuba). Get closer to the church and find information about masses in this place. Please, write below the hours of Sunday masses.

ANSWER: 7.00, 8.30, 9.30, 11.00, 12.15, 18.00

11. At the corner of Nowomiejski Market Square there is a chemist's. What animal can you see on the façade of the building?

ANSWER: LION

12. Now you have to find the "Nowomiejski Ogródek" (Nowomiejski Garden) where one of your teachers is awaiting you. Only two persons from your group may enter the place. Get involved in a conversation with the teacher and express the following:

- Zaproponuj rozmówcy pójście dziś wieczorem na spektakl muzyka-światło-woda.
- Odrzuć propozycję pójścia do kina, podając stosowny argument.
- Zapewnij rozmówcę, że będzie się świetnie bawił na widowisku z grającymi fontannami.

After the conversation with the teacher, please ask for another set of questions and tasks.

SET 3

13. Reach Staromiejski Market Square, look around and find the statute of a donkey at the corner of Szeroka and Żeglarska Streets. Read information about the statue from the board fixed on the neighbouring building and write down what the donkey was used for. One of you needs to sit on the donkey. Use the camera in your mobile phone and take a photo of your friend and the statue.

ANSWER: IN THE PAST THE DONKEY WAS USED FOR PUNISHING CRIMINALS. BECAUSE IT HAD A METAL ROD ALONG ITS BACK WHICH WAS EXTREMELY SHARP, THE PRISONERS WHO WERE FORCED TO SIT ON IT SUFFERED ENORMOUS PAIN.

14. Buy a beautiful rose from one of the florists at the Market Square. The rose must be very cheap. Negotiate the price with the florist. Ask her/him for the receipt.

15. At Staromiejski Market Square there is a department store. Please, enter it and find out what the following shops offer to customers and which floors they are located on:

16. Next to one of the corner lamp-posts at Staromiejski Market Square there is a dog with a hat in its muzzle and an umbrella nearby. Read information from the board of the corner building and find out the name of this dog.

ANSWER: THE DOG IS CALLED FILUŚ

17. There is a hotel at 21 Staromiejski Market Square. Look at the commemorative plaque on the façade of the building and enumerate the names of three prominent persons who stayed in this hotel.

ANSWER: MARIA KAZIMIERA (QUEEN OF POLAND), PIOTR I WIELKI (TSAR OF RUSSIA), AUGUST II MOCNY (KING OF POLAND)

18. Find the monument of a rafter near the Town Hall. Count little frogs surrounding the sculpture and touch one of them. Talk with Toruń citizens and try to learn the legend of the rafter and the frogs. Write below what the legend says.

ANSWER: THERE ARE 8 LITTLE FROGS SURROUNDING THE SCULPTURE. THE LEGEND SAYS THAT THE RAFTER WITH HIS BEAUTIFUL VIOLIN PLAYING ENCHANTED THOUSANDS OF FROGS RESIDING IN TORUŃ AND SUCCESSFULLY LED THEM AWAY FROM THE CITY.

19. Find the Main Post Office at Staromiejski Market Square. Don't get into the building, just walk around it and find the commemorative plaque on the wall. Read it quickly and write down when Napoleon stayed in this place. Specify days, month and the year.

ANSWER: 2-6 JUNE 1812

20. Now you need to head for the Artus Court. Please, ask some passerby in which direction to go in order to find the place. When you are there, look at the facade of the building, use your crayons and draw the court as realistically as possible.

21. Standing in front of the Artus Court, look down at the pavement. In this place you will see the Gingerbread Walk of Fame. Go along this path and find the autograph of the legendary rock-band called "Republika". Use the camera in your mobile phone and take a photo of their gingerbread.

28. Visit the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist. Read the information from the board located near the cathedral. Write down the name of the well-known person who was baptized in this church and give the weight of the bell which was hung in the cathedral tower in 1500.

ANSWERS: IT WAS NICHOLAS COPERNICUS WHO WAS BAPTIZED IN THIS CHURCH. THE WEIGHT OF THE BELL WHICH WAS HUNG IN THE CATHEDRAL TOWER IN 1500 WAS 7238 KILOGRAMMES

29. Walk quickly to the “Philadelphia” boat at the Philadelphia Boulevard. Get on board and find your teacher there. Ask him/her the following questions:

- Jaka rzeka przepływa przez Toruń?
- Kim był Tony Halik?
- W którym roku powstał Uniwersytet Mikołaja Kopernika?

Put down all the answers on the piece of paper. After the conversation with the teacher, give him/her the completed set. Hurry up. This is your finishing line. The prize is waiting for you!!!
